Deadline Extension Provided for Special Fittings

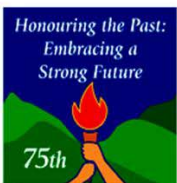
On June 4th, the Interprovincial Gas Advisory Committee (IGAC) informed CIPH that an extension will be granted for all appliance fittings that require certification to ULC S636. The new deadline is October 1, 2008, three months after the original deadline of July 1, 2008.

CIPH appliance manufacturers had written the IGAC requesting an extension until January 1, 2009 due to fears that limited product will be available on the market prior to that date.

Manufacturers have been experiencing delays in having product appropriately certified for various reasons including initial confusion outlining which special fittings were part of the venting system (vs. part of the appliance) as well as the fact that ULC S636 applies to venting systems, not individual components.
